

Course Title: Contemporary Continental Philosophy

Course description: This course focuses on what may be called “contemporary continental philosophy”. However, since contemporary philosophy is part and parcel of the Western philosophical tradition, we shall also read some classical texts. The central themes of the course are basic philosophical issues such as identity and difference, the same and the other, the human and the non-human, what is and what is not. The reading list includes Descartes, Leibniz, Kant, Bergson, Husserl, Heidegger, Scheler, Lacan, Deleuze, Foucault, Derrida, Nancy, Agamben, and Butler.
