Course title: Applied cinematography

Course type: Practical course

Course content: The student should have a solid knowledge about the workflow of the filmmaking, the process of creation, the creative skills and the technical

This workshop presupposes no prior knowledge of Cinematography, but aims to have students confident in the

fundamentals of cinematic language by the end of the year.

Class participation: Continuous attendance and in-class activity is required.
